1973 Annual Kentucky Derby of Cycling

April 21-22, 1973

- EVENTS:** Ladies Race - 10 mile (ABL of A)
Junior Race - (17 and under as of 1/1/73) 10 mile (ABL of A)
Senior Race - 50 mile "Run for the Roses" (ABL of A)
- ASSEMBLY POINT:** Federal Building -- Sixth and Chestnut Street
- TIME:** 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. First call for first race at 12:45 P.M.
- ASSEMBLY TIME:** 12:00 P.M.
- COURSE:** Rectangular course on downtown city streets. Newly paved streets, essentially flat, long straight-away. Four turns. No blind or off-camber turns. Lapped riders pulled from race.
- AWARDS:** Prizes totaling \$1,000. Will include silver awards and super-racing equipment. Sprint prizes in each race. Presentation -- after the last race. Each rider will receive a swiss-embroidered patch of the Kentucky Derby of Cycling.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$2.00 -- Entries must be postmarked prior to April 21, 1973.
- LATE AND POST ENTRIES:** \$4.50 as stated by ABL of A regulations.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Riders must present valid ABL of A amateur cards. Foreign amateur cards are accepted for foreign entries. Note: For non-ALB of A riders, an ALB of A registration table will be opened at 12:00 P.M. race day. Non-members must have completed registration by the start of the races. ALB of A membership fee is \$5.00.
- EQUIPMENT:** Road bikes only. Helmets must be worn. Tires must be securely attached to rims. All equipment is subject to inspection before use.
- RACING COSTUMES:** ABL of A rules state: "Racing costumes shall be such as to cover the shoulders and breeches must reach to within about 6 inches of the knees. All breeches (leg tights) must be black in color, though shirts of any color may be used. These requirements must be strictly enforced by the referee."
- FREE ROOM FRIDAY NIGHT:** Free sleeping bag space at Boy's Haven. Located at 3201 Bardstown Road adjacent to the Holiday Inn Southeast -- right off the Watterson Expressway on the Bardstown Road - South Exit.
