CLUB RACES - Alan Bolton

There seems to be some confusion concerning the awarding of points to club members. I hope the outline below will explain it.

The point system is as follows:

There will be 3 places for riders in the Time Trials and Road Races, based on age groups.

5 points for every event completed. Time Trials

Placing Points

1st = 10 points 2nd = 8 points

3rd = 6 points

4th = % points, 4 ; 5th = 2 points

Road Races 5 points for every event completed.

"B" race (short) "A" race (long)

1st = 5 points 1st = 10 points 2nd = 4 points 2nd = 8 points

3rd = 3 points 3rd = 6 points 4th = 2 point , 5th = 1

4th = 2 points 4 , 5th = 2

ABL of A Races 10 points for every event completed.

Placing Points 6th = 10 points 1st = 20 points 7th = 8 points

2nd = 18 points 8th = 6 points 3rd = 16 points

9th = 4 points 4th = 14 points 10th = 2 points5th = 12 points

(The above will apply even if the prizes are not awarded down to 10 places.)

Club Champion will be the member accumulating the most club & ABL of A points.
