Our club's leadership has been greatly helped by interested parties, namely by Phil Kennedy, Jr., whose son, Phil the Third, has made a name for himself in cycling in one short season as an Intermediate, by Watson Nordquist, our esteemed Veteran, who has given freely of his time and words of wisdom, and Alan Bolton, who despite a busy schedule, found time to help us, by Dan Humpert, who chauffeured racers to the time trials, and rode in them himself, by Stu Pray, whose wry sense of humor and advice helped to lighten the load, and all the rest of you who contributed to the running of the club. Thank you all very much.

We lost our Secretary, Frank Gall, early in the season, due to the fact that he felt he could not serve and still maintain all of his other obligations. But Donny Schilling stepped in, and we are grateful to him.

And it is with regret we tell you that Les Gesell, our President, was forced to resign because of his Doctorate program at U.C. taking so much of his time. We wish you all the best, Les, and hope that you elect to stay in the Cincinnati area! With Les's resignation, the vice-president takes over his duties. So now the President of the club is Bill Gallagher.

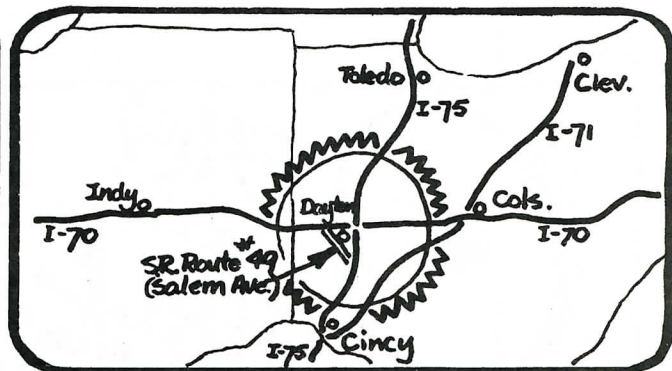

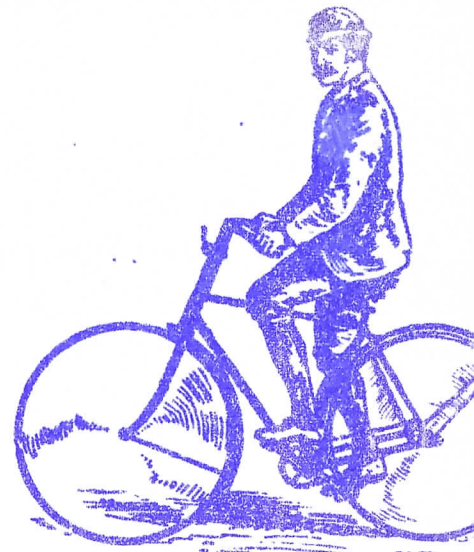
