SO THE REAL REASON FOR THIS NEWSLETTER IS TO ANNOUNCE THE ABOVE RACE. YES, THE QCW IS GOING TO PUT ON ANOTHER RACE THIS YEAR! THE RIVERTOWN CLASSIC/GRAN PRIX OF CYCLING WILL BE HELD AUGUST 21, ON A RATHER DEMANDING COURSE IN THE VICINITY OF LYTLE PARK. (SEE MAP) CO-SPONSORING THE EVENT IS THE DOWNTOWN COUNCIL OF THE CINCINNATI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

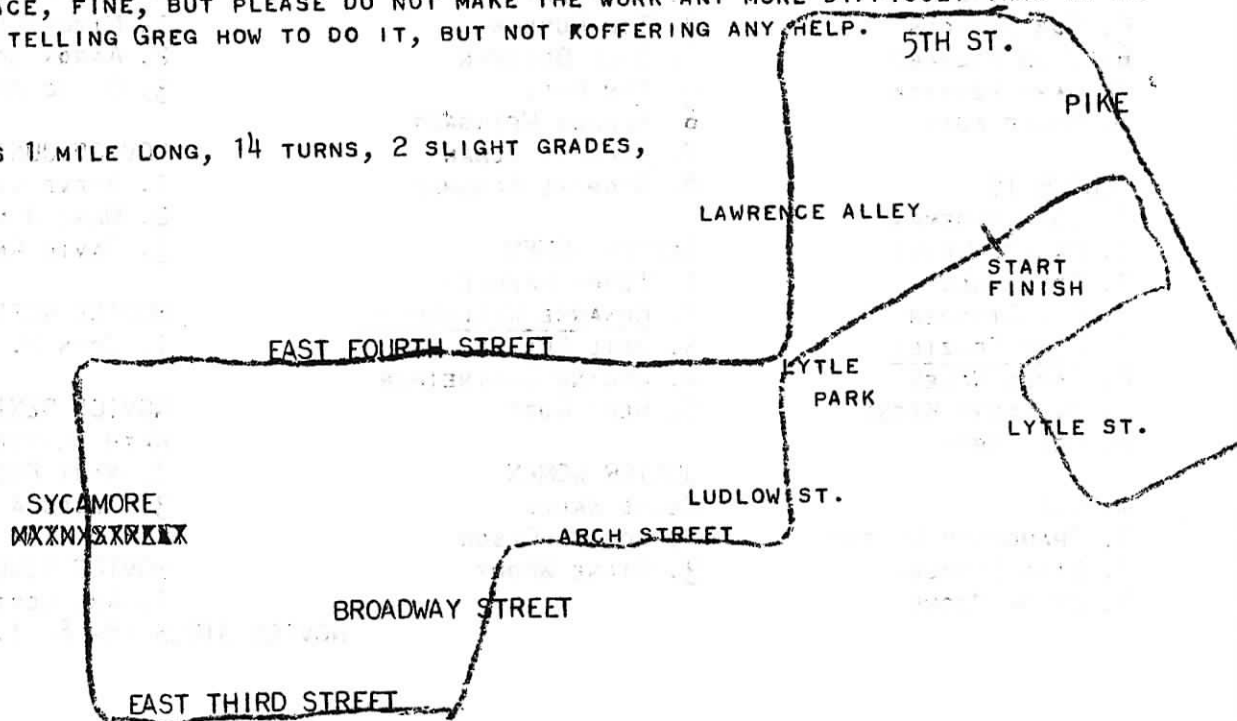
THE ADVANTAGE TO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE INVOLVEMENT IS ALREADY EVIDENT. THEY'VE PLEDGED A PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGN, (LIKE WE-VE NEVER HAD FOR A RACE BEFORE), PORTABEE GRANDSTAND, PUBLIC ADDRESS, SCORERS PLATFORM, CROWD AND TRAFFIC CONTROL, USE OF LYTLE PARK AND THE GUILFORD SCHOOL LOT, AS WELL AS, ADDITIONAL COMFORT FACILITIES, SHOWERS, AND MANPOWER THE DAY OF THE RACE. THE CHAMBER IS SHOT IN THE HEAD OVER THE IDEA AND WITH THEIR HELP THE RIVERTOWN CLASSIC WILL BE THE BEST RACE THE QUEEN CITY WHEELMEN HAS EVER PROMOTED.

THE COURSE WAS DESIGNED TO CHALLENGE THE CYCLIST AND TO CENTRALIZE RACING ACTIVITY TO MAINTAIN SPECTATOR INTEREST. SPECIAL FEATURES INCLUDE 14 CORNERS, AN ALLEY, AND TWO MODERATE CLIMBS. IT WILL BE VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE FOR ANYONE BUT A STRONG, AGGRESSIVE BIKE HANDLER TO WIN ON THIS COURSE!

WCET HAS EXPRESSED INTEREST IN TAPING PORTIONS OF THE RACE FOR BROADCAST AND WE CAN CERTAINLY EXPECT EXCELLENT NEWS COVERAGE FROM WCPO & WLWT. WITH THE WAY THE CHAMBER PLANS ON PUBLICIZING THIS EVENT THE AMOUNT OF RECOGNITION BICYCLE RACING IN CINCINNATI GAINS WILL BE PHENOMINAL.

NEEDLESS TO SAY THIS WOULD BE AN INAPPROPRIATE TIME FOR THE QCW TO LAY AN EGG—THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IS SIMPLY NOT INTERESTED IN PROMOTING A "TURKEY" RACE. NOR IS THE MEDIA TOO CRAZY ABOUT FILMING A FLOP. SO NOW IS THE TIME TO COME TO THE AID OF YOU CLUB. YOU CAN DO SO BY CONTACTING THE RACE CHAIRMAN, GREG HANFBAUER, 921-3049, IF YOU'D LIKE TO HELP WITH SOME OF THE PRELIMINARY WORK. GREG CAME UP WITH THE IDEA FOR THE RACE, WORKED THE COURSE OUT WITH JON SPICKER, AND THE PRESENTED THE PACKAGE TO THE DOWNTOWN COUNCIL. SO FAR GREG HAS DONE NEARLY ALL THE WORK, WITH JON SPICKER DOING THE REST, AND THEY COULD CERTINLY USE SOME HELP, IF NOTHING ELSE MORAL SUPPORT. THE LAST THING GREG WANTS TO HEAR RITE NOW IS A BUNCH OF REASONS WHY WE SHOULD NOT HOLD THIS RACE— IT WILL BE HELD—AND GREG DOESN-T WANT TO LISTEN TO 50 REASONS WHY YOU CAN-T DO THIS OR THAT. IF YOU ARE NOT INTERESTED IN HELPING WITH THIS MOST IMPORTANT RACE, FINE, BUT PLEASE DO NOT MAKE THE WORK ANY MORE DIFFICULT THAN IT ALREADY IS BY TELLING GREG HOW TO DO IT, BUT NOT KOFFERING ANY HELP.

CLUB TIME TRIALS 10MILES

THE BROWER RD. TIME TRIAL SERIES IS SCHEDULED TO COMMENCE THE SECOND TUESDAY IN MAY AT 6:30 PM. LAST YEARS TIMER MARK VINCENT HAS AGREED TO A RETURN ENGAGEMENT BUT A ALTERNATE OR ASSISTANT TIMERS ARE ALWAYS WELCOME; IF NOT A STARK NECESSITY.

WE'LL NOT BORE YOU WITH A LOT OF PARTICULARS ABOUT THE COURSE AS TIME TRIAL COURSES BY NATURE ARE UNBELIEVABLY BORE DULL. IT'S THE PARTICIPANT WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE GOOD TIMES ON THE BIKE AS HE CONTINUES TO IMPROVE HIS PERFORMANCE AGAINST THE CLOCK.

AND YOU'LL CERTAINLY NOT WANT TO MISS THE OPPORTUNITY TO MEET WITH THE OTHER MEMBERS TO FIND OUT WHAT'S GOING ON. WE JUST CAN'T SEEM TO GET BIKIES TO A MEETING WHEN THE WEATHER'S NICE; AND THE NEWSLETTER HAS PROVEN ITSELF TO BE UNRELIABLE AT BEST. THIS IS NOT ONE OF THE BEST.

FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO FORGOT A TIME TRIAL IS WHERE THE RIDERS MUST RIDE BY THEMSELVES WITHOUT ANY DRAFTING AND RACE AGAINST THE CLOCK. ACTUALLY YOU ONLY GET TIMED FROM THE CLOCK AND ARE RACING AGAINST YOUR CLUB MATES. REMEMBER WE ARE ALWAYS LOOKING FOR MORE RIDERS FOR THE TIME TRIALS, AND YOU MAY BRING ALONG A NON-MEMBER OR TWO WITH YOU.
