When coming into New Haven on New Haven road turn right at the flashing yellow light and then left onto baughan. The next intersection is Edgewood, where you want to turn ~~right~~ right. The start finish will be somewhere in the vicinity of the intersection of Lee Creek and Edgewood.

This new course should allow many more people to enjoy the Club Road Races, which are one ~~of~~ of the best places to learn riding and racing techniques. The races will still be approx. 20 miles in length.
