ACTIVITIES & IDEAS IN SEARCH OF CHAIRMEN AND/OR VOLUNTEERS

Training Ride Coordinator: Presently the Sunday training rides are scheduled to leave Clifton at 9:15 AM and head west through Ross to Oxford and return. The distance is approximately 100 miles. Earlier turn arounds are at the option of the individual.

A coordinator is necessary to:

- (1) Map an eastern route.
- (2) Give route and other information to new riders.
- (3) Develop tentative schedule for publication in newsletter
- (4) Be accessible by phone.

Burnet Woods Criterium Chairman: Once regarded as the "Best in the Midwest", there is still a lot of interest in this event. It didn't happen in '80. To make sure it gets off the ground in '81, we need to start putting things together now.

- (1) Select date 1st or 2nd Sunday in April.
- (2) Obtain commitment from Park Board.
- (3) Advise State Reps to avoid conflicting schedules.
- (4) Prepare race applications and distribute.
- (5) Line up prizes.
- (6) Public Relations.
- (7) Recruit volunteers.

Note: To use park property, we must furnish liability insurance which will cost approximately \$200. This leaves the race chairman only \$100 or so to spend in excess of entry fees.

Roller Exhibition Chairman: From time to time, those among us who have some style have the opportunity to show off and promote cycling as well as the Queen City Wheelmen. We just set up the rollers and ride them at some public gathering. We've even rented a roller race set from Kettering for special occasions: Bob Hart Sports Show, U.C. Spring

If sufficient financial support is available, a legitimate roller race is possible for Novice & USCF classes. A shopping mall is the ideal location for such an event.
