But no local shop does a decent job, in my opinion, of bringing in good, proven stuff. They just sell what's easy to get, and that is often what did not sell in the major cities. Here are my own picks:

1. DUEGI LEXAN SOLE SHOES (SALE)
White perforated leather (and a couple of black pair) in stock. Duegi wood soles have always been great, but a little two stiff. These have the same great fit, high arch, and superior quality, but just a ting of flex. To introduce them to Cincinnati, I put a super hot price on them!

GIORDANA SKIN SHORTS AND BIBS

These shorts and bibs have Italian quality, padded chamois and long legs to avoid chafing. Again, a hot introductory price, only until July 15! Regular price for shorts: \$30.00/Bibs: \$37.50.
