1988 DATA SHEET

Queen City Wheels (QCW) is greater Cincinnati's oldest and most successful bicycle racing club. QCW hosts fast-paced training rides and time trials for both licensed racers and unlicensed riders.

For 18 years QCW has hosted a weekly 10.2 mile time trial event each Tuesday evening from May until October. QCW promotes a day of racing on the Fourth of July in Blue Ash. Several alternative training rides are available during the week. Rides are operated on a 'show & go' basis; membership is required for time trialing and training rides. A telephone 'RIDE' line is available continuously. Other activities include weight training and roller riding in the winter months. The season ends in November with an Awards Banquet that is attended by most club members.

Queen City Wheels was formed in 1967. QCW has been a sanctioned member club of the Amateur Bicycle League of America (ABLA) and its successor the United States Cycling Federation (USCF) since 1972. The USCF governs all amateur bicycle racing in the United States and qualifies riders for the Olympics, World Championships, and other international competitions. As a USCF member club, QCW and its licensed members are fully insured when participating in USCF sanctioned events.

QCW has produced several nationally known riders; has two former women members on the U.S. National Road Racing team; has held various state championships; has set one recognized USCF National record; has had a member ride in the prestigious Race Across America (RAAM); and had three finishers in the 1987 Ironman Triathlon in Hawaii.

In 1987 QCW had 175 individual dues paying members ranging in age from 13 to 69 years young. Over 40% are licensed riders. QCW is 20% female and 18% students. Over 85% of QCW members participated in QCW time trials and/or USCF sanctioned local, State and National racing programs. QCW riders log between two and eleven thousand training miles each year.

Every person who participates as a competitor in USCF sanctioned events must apply for and hold a separate amateur racing license, for which an additional annual fee is required by the USCF. A person does not have to hold a USCF license to belong to the QCW, and all members of the club whether licensed or not, may compete against each other in club events. On Saturdays and/or Sundays, many club members travel to various cities throughout the Midwest to participate in USCF-sanctioned races.

HELMETS ARE ALWAYS REQUIRED BY CLUB POLICY AND USCF RULES.



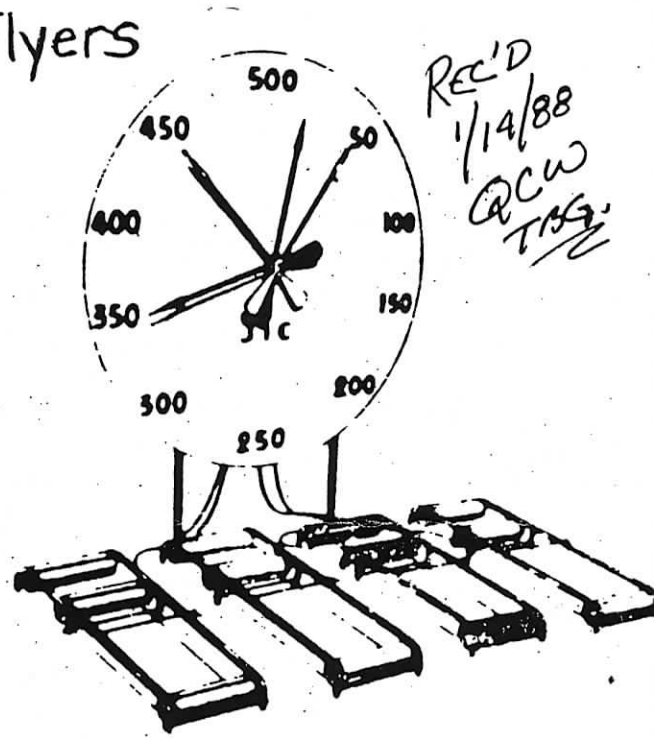
