One of the obligations of membership in QCW has always been a share of the work. Although QCW has a large number of volunteers, there are some members who have not yet had an opportunity to contribute. We want to extend that opportunity to everyone.

The Club at its 1987 Annual Meeting approved QCW's involvement with the CYCLEBRATION '88 racing series with all of the inherent implications for each member. ## MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:

- 1. Included is a Citizens Race Entry Form for unlicensed riders. If you or a friend want to race in the Blue Ash DASH Citizens Event fill this out and return it immediately. Citizens forms will be available in local bike shops after June 7th and racing fields are limited by USCF. If you want a guaranteed starting position return this before June 14th. All licensed riders should have received a separate entry form previously.
- 2. Three raffle tickets are enclosed to help QCW generate some funds for the race teams. QCW is promoting the Blue Ash DASH as a volunteer event and as such will receive no funding from it. The QCW Board of Trustees has elected to promote a raffle in conjunction with the Blue Ash DASH so that we come away with something for the Club. The first place award will be a Cannondale/Shimano 105 racing bicycle worth \$675.00. The final raffle awards list is still growing. We expect 5 or 6 major awards including a special HUFFY/LeMond series, all alloy, racing bicycle. Only a limited number of tickets are available.
